Canoeing –(Scouts only) – A timed event including paddling and portaging.

Rowing – Row the boat to a treasure. Retrieve the treasure, row to buoys and identify them. Webelos will have a simplified course.

Armageddon –Catch wateroids falling from Earth orbit.

Bucket Brigade (Webelos only) – Save the burning building. Get water to the top of the hill as quickly as possible.

Swimming Relay – Four legs. One each of backstroke, sidestroke, breast stroke, and freestyle. Webelos will not use a baton. Scouts will use a baton. Seniors will have to put on a shirt (will be provided at the station), swim the leg, take off the shirt and pass it to the next member.

Firebuilding – Start a fire on a platform in the water (or mire). Matches only, which will be provided. Otherwise, provide your own knives, hatchets, and/or saws.

Inner tube Raft – Inner tubes and twine are provided. You provide the skill to make a raft and propel it out in the lake and around a buoy. You must have shoes that can get wet. No bare feet.

Knots On the Water – Swimmers will tread water while tying knots. Beginners and non-swimmers can participate in the wading area. Seniors can only use one arm, but may work together.

Duck blind – Shoot closest to the target center. 22's for Scouts and BB guns for Webelos.

Lifesaving/ First Aid – Given a problem, rescue and give first aid to the victim.

Splicing (Scouts only) – You will be given rope at the beginning of the day and have the day to tie an eye splice, a short splice, and an end splice. We'll also ask for a Monkey's Fist.

Scavenger Hunt (Webelos only) – Collect a list of items and turn them in at the end of the day.

Measurement – During the day, Scouts will be given a height question and a distance question. Turn in your answers along with your splices at the end of the day.
