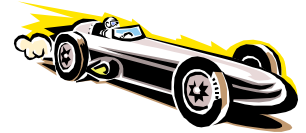


Joyce Kilmer District Pinewood Derby 2010



Speedway



Registration: by Pack Representative



Race Day: April 25th, 2010
Racing Commences at 12:30pm



Race Format: Cars will be raced by rank groupings. Tiger, Open class & Siblings will race as group 1. Wolf, & Bear entrants will race as group 2. Web1 & Web2 will follow as group 3. Group start times will be on the website the week before the races. Grand Champion races follow the Webelos and the days racing will conclude with adult & scout 18 wheel trucks. Each entrant will run once in each of the six lanes of our track. These qualifying heats will be randomly generated based on the number of entries. Vehicles may or may not run in consecutive heats. Efforts to race as many of the other vehicles are made so each entrant has a potential of racing vs 30 other vehicles so it is very likely they will get to compete against most, if not all, of their friends. When there are less than 31 vehicles they WILL race all the other vehicles in that group, some of them more than once.

Scoring of the races will be based solely on time. When 2 or more vehicles do not pass the finish line, they are scored in order from closest to the finish line. Trophies will be awarded to the winners of each group.

The GRAND CHAMPION will be determined after all the ranks have finished racing. The three fastest winners of each rank advances to the Grand Champion race. The 15 vehicles will race each other with a clean slate, no times are kept from the early rounds, once in each of the lanes. The best finisher will be the GRAND CHAMPION. In the event of a tie, those cars tied will continue in a runoff until a clear winner is decided. Racers in the Grand Champion race will be registered for the Central New Jersey Pinewood Derby to be held the following week.
